26 March – 2 August 2026

This exhibition will present around forty works from the prestigious American institution, including paintings by Golden Age masters such as Velázquez, El Greco, and Zurbarán.

The exhibition offers both a retrospective of his work and an exploration of his impact on 19th-century French painting, extending to the profound interpretation given by Jean-Paul Sartre.

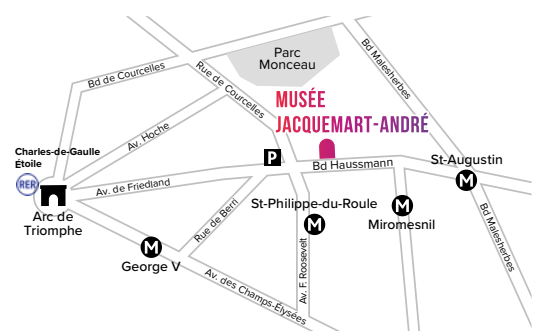
